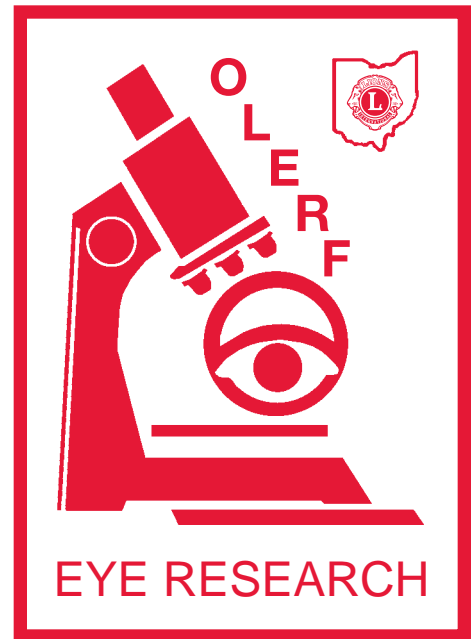

## *OLERF President's Message*

*Lions all over the world have been working together to answer the needs that challenge communities and the world. But in 1925, Helen Keller addressed the Lions Clubs International convention in Cedar Point, OH and challenged Lions to become "Knights of the Blind" in a crusade against darkness. Her memorable speech has driven lions all over the world to aid in the fight of preventable blindness. In Ohio, the lions have accepted Helen Keller's challenge and have made it a priority. We believe that a cure for preventable blindness lies in research.*

*Back in 1952, the Ohio Lions Eye Research committee held its first meeting at the state convention in Cincinnati. First donations were made by the Athens club, the Hollansburg club and the Middleton club. Three individuals also made very generous donations. From that point in history, due to the very generous donations of Ohio Lions, OLERF has donated more than six million dollars to Ohio eye research institutions.*

*In the 1960's OLERF funded research at Case Western Reserve University into a new process called ULTRASOUND. At the time it was started, this brand new technology could be used for detecting eye pathology in patients with cataracts. Ultra sound allows the doctor to "see" beyond the cloudy lens as in the Today ultrasound is standard practice and used world-wide and cataract surgery is routine.*

*The UN General Assembly has estimated that more than 230 million people have diabetes. This number is expected to rise to a staggering 350 million by 2025. As a result, every year 12,000 to 24,000 go blind due to diabetic retinopathy. OLERF is funding research at Ohio State where scientists are working to create a cure for this disease. Some day due to this research at Ohio State, diabetic retinopathy will be extinguished.*

**Scientific Chair's Report**  
Lion L. E. Leguire Ph.D., MBA

As I review grant applications from the six Ohio institutions funded by the OLERF, I am struck by the diversity of projects and wide range of eye diseases under investigation. Chances are that you or one of your family members is affected by one or more of these eye diseases.

Amblyopia, commonly known as lazy eye, is being studied at Nationwide Children's Hospital and amblyopia affects about 1 in every 33 children. Researchers at NCH have pioneered the use of a drug, L-dopa, commonly used in Parkinson's disease, to treat older children with amblyopia. This pioneering research has been funded by OLERF for the past 20 years and the fruits of this pilot funding is paying off. The use of L-dopa to treat amblyopia is now being studied worldwide. In the USA, a national multicenter clinical trial is underway. If successful, this national study will alter the standard therapy for amblyopia which hasn't changed much in over 200 years!

Age-related macular degeneration (AMD) is the leading cause of vision loss in people over the age of 65, and I don't have to tell you that many LIONS members are 65 and older. AMD dramatically increases with age – white males over the age of 79 have a 1 in 9 chance of having the disease while white women have a 1 in 6 chance of having AMD. New therapies for the wet form of AMD, the worse type, are being studied at OSU Ophthalmology and Case Western Reserve University Ophthalmology. Some of these therapies involve VEGF (vascular endothelial growth factor) and new delivery systems to provide long term drug therapy. CWRU is investigating and identifying the genes responsible for AMD with the ultimate goal of developing a gene therapy for AMD. At Wright State University, investigators are looking at ways to limit the progression of the disease with the use of vitamin supplements and better understanding of the influence of environmental light on disease progression. The OLERF has recently established a fund dedicated to AMD research – The Richard "Dick" Neiderhauser fund for research into Age-related Macular Degeneration and allied retinal diseases.

Diabetic eye disease will affect 23.5% of people over the age of 50 years. Diabetic retinopathy affects 10.2%, cataracts affect 31.8%, and people with diabetes are more likely to have glaucoma (8%) than people without diabetes (4.3%). OLERF funded investigators at CWRU are investigating cataract formation in people with diabetes with the goal to prevent or retard the formation of cataracts. These OLERF investigators are also studying blood vessel cell death in diabetic patients which leads to diabetic retinopathy. Recently, these investigators have discovered a relation between high glucose in diabetic patients and death of blood vessel cells. This research may lead to novel therapies for diabetic retinopathy. OLERF has established a dedicated fund for diabetic eye disease – The W. R. Bryan Diabetic Eye Disease research Fund.

Other vision problems being studied by OLERF investigators include myopia (nearsightedness), cornea disease and injury repair, dry eye disease, retinal degenerations including retinitis pigmentosa (RP), effects of refractive surgery on the cornea, pseudo tumor cerebri, keratoconus, use of medical plants and herbs for eye disease, glaucoma and melanoma associated eye disease, among others. It is safe to say that support for the OLERF supports research into one or more eye diseases which affect us all.
